2. Closing of the Ranges

The only item on the Agenda was to discuss a proposed date to close both indoor and outdoor ranges in light of the second lockdown announced by the Government on 31 October 2020 in response to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Pete stated Thea had sent her views via a text from her father and had said she would agree with whatever the consensus was between the adult committee members.

It was agreed between those present that the last indoor shooting session should be Wednesday 4 November 2020. It was the general consensus that archers would continue to make their own decision about whether they felt safe to come to the range, and if we got the position where there was not enough people to assist in setting up or taking down the range, then the range would close for that session in any event.

Archery GB had not yet issued any guidance and if they were to announce that ranges must close with immediate effect then of course we would do so. We also did not have any information from Easton College, but again if they were to close immediately then we would have little choice but to do so as well.

Pete agreed he would contact all beginners and cancel their upcoming sessions with immediate effect. They are likely to need a refresher session when they come back, hopefully in December, which would obviously be at no extra cost to them.
